Flu Season

What is flu? Flu is a virus infection; it could be mild or severe. Mostly the effect of flu starts from the respiratory system and spreads to whole body. When severe, flu can cause sinus infection and even pneumonia.

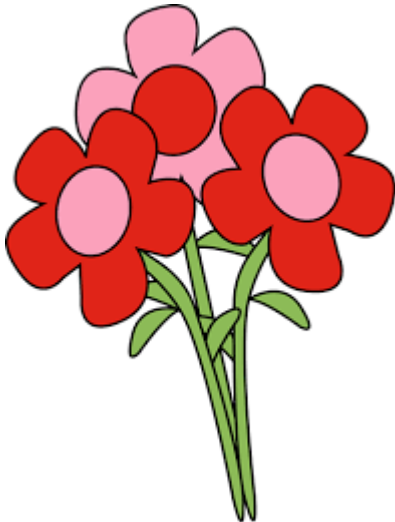
Flu symptoms are just like the common cold, high fever, cough, headache, tiredness and muscle pain.

It is important to take a flu shot before the season starts in September. In case if you still get flu, the strength of virus will be milder. However, if you did not get the flu vaccine (shot) at all then it could be very painful and long recovery.

In children, symptoms of flu are diarrhea, abdominal pain, vomiting with fever. However, for adults, diarrhea is uncommon.

How to protect from flu? Most importantly, we should wash our hands thoroughly with soap every time we come in contact with a sick person or visit a public place like park or school.

For a fast recovery, drink lots of liquid, take plenty of rest and take anti-viral medicine. If you are feeling dehydrated, you should immediately go to the Emergency Room.

Language Arts---- Letters I, J, K, L. The subjects of diversity and kindness introduced through discussion, dramatic play and books. Using two or more words to describe weather and objects in the room.

Writing---- Worksheets using featured letters, writing numbers when using measuring tape, rulers and yardstick.

Math---- An inch is a unit of measure. Use unit blocks to measure items in the room. Use 12" ruler to measure; less than, more than and equal to. $3 \times 12" = 1 \text{ yard}$. 4 quarters = \$1.00

Science---- Watching the temperature to know if we are going outside; it must be 32 degrees or above. Exploring our five senses through stories and exploration. Want to know more? Ask your child.
